NAPLAN:

Individual Student Results for NAPLAN were sent home earlier this week for students in Year 3 and 5. As of 2023, a new proficiency standard was introduced for NAPLAN reporting. The standard will replace the numerical NAPLAN bands and the national minimum standard with the following four levels of achievement:

Exceeding

Strong

Developing

Needs additional support.

The report showed results for each NAPLAN test through proficiency level. These levels show what students know and are able to do in literacy and numeracy.


