- Social Skills Program \$350
- Sensory Ninja Program \$300
- Art Venture Program \$350

New clients will need to be engaged in a pre-assessment session prior to engaging in the program. The fee is \$86.79.

What is included in the Program?

For current and existing clients of Stepping Stones in Life Therapy Service the Intensive School Holiday Program includes:

- 3hr intensive program across 4 days

For new clients to Stepping Stones in Life Therapy Service the Intensive School Holiday Program includes:

- A pre-assessment (45min) to ensure your child is group ready and suitable for the program (billed separately to the Program Fee)
- 3hr intensive program

Fees also include the time spent by clinicians to design and develop the program, resources used for the program, and time to set up and clean up.

General information:

Privately paying clients are welcome.



Medicare Rebates and Private Health Rebates do not apply to these programs.

As we are a registered NDIS provider, NDIS funding can be used to fund this program. If you are unsure whether you can use your child's NDIS funds, please consult your COS or LAC.

Children are required to be dropped off, and signed in for a 9:00am start and collected on time for a 12pm finish. Please ensure that you are in our clinic no later than 11:55am to sign your child out. A late collection fee will be charged at \$15 for the first 5 minutes and then \$10 every 10 minutes after that.

Parents and caregivers are not required to stay for the program.

Each program will run for 3hrs across the 4 days Tuesday- Friday.

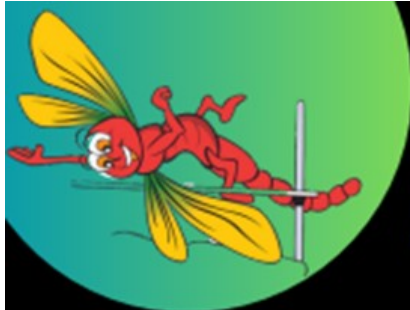
