Dear families,

How wonderful that the Dry season seems to have arrived, a very pleasant weekend with comfortable temperatures and I am sure many of you took the opportunity to enjoy some outdoors activities.

Why is it important for your child to arrive to school on time:

Our school day begins at 8:10am with the music signalling the children to make their way to their classrooms. There are many benefits your child will gain from arriving to school on time:

- They are present for the morning class routine and this is when the teacher will go through the daily timetable.
- Special announcement and messages are given over the PA daily.
- Ensures your child doesn't miss out on the important learning activities that happen early in the day when they are most alert.
- Helps your child to learn about routines and commitment.
- Gives your child time to greet their friends before class, this can reduce the possibility of disruptions in the classroom.

Sometimes it can be challenging for parents to get their child/ren to school on time. Try some of these tips on setting regular routines:

- Have a set time to go to bed.
- Have a set time to be out of bed.
- Have uniform and school bag ready the night before.
- Have set time for starting and ending breakfast.
- Give your child lots of positive encouragement and acknowledge when they are organised and get to school on time.
- On arrival look for some of your child's friends and encourage them to go off and play together.
- Once settled leave quickly.
