Dear Parents and Carers

INDUSTRIAL ACTION – STOP WORK - Thursday 1st September Parap Primary School will be affected by the industrial action but <u>will</u> <u>remain open</u>.

Every effort will be made to minimise impacts on learning and ensure appropriate supervision is in place for students to ensure their safety and wellbeing. We have had to modify timetables and combine year levels to support reductions in staffing.

All students are asked to come to the Hall at the beginning of the day, with their bags, hats, lunchboxes and water bottles. We will be grouping students in the following combinations.

Preschool and Transition Year One and Year Two Year Three and Year Four Year Five and Year Six All of our students will have an executive staff member (Principal or Assistant Principals), support staff and the teaching staff who are not participating in the action, to look after them on Thursday. Formal learning will not be possible however we have organised activities for each group which include, sport, technology, games and puzzles.

At the end of the day you will be able to collect your child from the Hall or Camp Australia if they attend After School Care.


INDUSTRIAL ACTION - WORK TO RULE

SWIMMING

The **Primary Years Swimming Training Program** (Year 4 – Year 6) began on Monday 29th August (Week 7) and has been extended to Thursday 8th September (Week 8).

These students will attend a trial swimming lesson on Thursday 8th September to ascertain that they can swim 50 metres confidently. 
