### 2026 FOCUS ENGLISH

Strengthen the whole-school English instructional model.

Develop a consistent English Scope and Sequence aligned to ACARA.

Establish a shared approach to teaching English across the school.

Implement clear guidelines for pre- and post-assessments.

Use Common Assessment Tasks consistently.

Review and monitor marking guides and rubrics.

Embed data folders so students can explain their learning progress.

Embed SMART goals within Three-Way Conferences.

Track engagement through observation cycles and walk-throughs.

Apply high-impact teaching strategies to increase engagement.

Align ICT scope and sequence to support engagement.

Create a clear English teaching guide for Parap.

Review English programs and assessments for impact.

Clarify expectations for differentiation in classrooms.

Use data to support differentiation and goal setting.

Explore QAAC cycles, particularly for writing.

Provide targeted intervention and extension opportunities.

Expand student leadership and voice (SRC, RLI, surveys).

Strengthen student understanding of differentiation and ICT use.

Continue tracking engagement using shared strategies.
