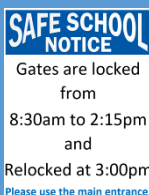

Please note the following costume requirements for your child/ children:

Transitions: Yellow t-shirts & black shorts (Face paint supplied: Simba red paint thumb smear on forehead).

Year 2 Giallouris: (Zazu) Plain white t-shirt and blue school shorts (feather boas & hat beaks supplied).

Year 2 Liveris: (Simba) Plain yellow t-shirt & black shorts (crowns provided).

Year 2 Chappell / 1 Rowe: (Roar) Jungle print or camouflage t-shirts and blue school shorts.

1 Sinclair: (Hakuna Matata) Hawaiian Shirts & Leis. Girls: Hula skirts Boys: Board shorts.

Year 3s: Bright plain coloured t-shirts (any colour without pictures or logos) and blue school shorts.

6/5 Bound / 1 Cooper: (Scar's Tango) Green and black clothes, dresses or skirts. (Green waist sash supplied).
