SWIMMING

The **Primary Years Swimming Training Program** (Year 4 – Year 6) will run from Monday 29th August (Week 7) to Tuesday the 6th September (Week 8). Students will attend 4 training sessions in total at the Parap Pool and then will participate in the PY Swimming Carnival. Notes regarding swimming have been sent out this week.

The Swimming Carnival will be held on Friday 9th September.

Swimming is an important component of the Australian Physical Education Curriculum. We are very pleased to have Mr Daniel Gerlach, a qualified swimming instructor and owner of Swim Dynamics, coordinating our training sessions with his swimming instructing team again this year. They offer an excellent program to revise and develop the swimming skills of our students. Daniel and his team will be working with students to ensure that they are well prepared for our PY Swimming Carnival and the possibility

Year 3 students who turn 9 this year may be eligible for the PY Swimming Carnival 9 year old age group. If they are part of the Darwin, Nightcliff or Casuarina Swimming Club they will have the opportunity of then representing our school at the Interschool Swimming Competition in Week 9. These students will attend a trial swimming lesson on Thursday 1st September to ascertain that they can swim 50 metres confidently. Mr Daniel Gerlach will assess their swimming capability and eligibility for swimming events in the carnival. Allocation of events will be at the sole discretion of Mr Daniel Gerlach and his swimming instructors.

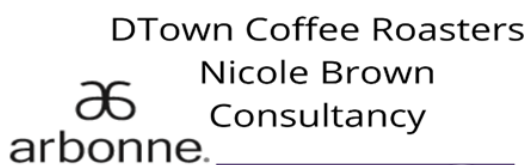
