I had the privilege of attending last week's Leaders' Summit hosted by the NT Department of Education. Among the keynote speakers was Kristen Hansen, renowned for her work in Neuroscience. Exploring the links between brain function and education was fascinating. Our brains evolve as we learn, from childhood through various stages of life. When children enter school, their brain circuits adapt to new learning, such as translating letters into words and numbers into mathematical concepts. Scientists and educators now collaborate to study how schooling shapes brain development, aiming to enhance the learning process based on their findings.

Our understanding of early school years' brain development is growing rapidly, thanks to tools like MRI and brain-wave sensors, along with open-science practices. These advancements reveal insights into reading, math, attention circuits, and diverse neurodiversity among schoolchildren. As educators, we need to reevaluate student perspectives, tailor teaching approaches, acknowledge emotions in learning, expand our methods, observe how learning influences the brain, and offer novel forms of feedback.

The Melbourne Cup is visiting Parap on **Friday 15th September (Week 9, Term 3)** at 8:30am in the hall. We don't have an assembly that week but the students and staff will assemble together, there will be guest speakers as well as a viewing of the Melbourne Cup.




